62nd Annual Exhibition 24th July – 9th August 2008

Telfer Hall, Gypsy Lane

- (a) Only fully paid-up members may enter pictures
- (b) Each member may enter up to **5** works. One of these can be a 3D piece. Each picture must be capable of being hung as a single unit on our screens. The maximum total area of pictures allowed is 25 square feet, with no single picture greater than 12 square feet or weighing more than 15 lbs. A maximum of 3 will be hung initially. The remaining selected entries may be exhibited as space becomes available either during the first hanging or later. Only one entry can be NFS (Not for Sale).
- (c) Entries must be the artist's own original work and should not have been exhibited previously in the *Exmouth Art Group* Summer Exhibition. Photocopies, prints or computer-generated images are not eligible.
- (d) The maximum weight of any 3-D entry is 25 lbs, and each must be stable (and include a stand if needed).
- (e) All entries are subject to selection and will be exhibited at the discretion of the President.
- (f) *Exmouth Art Group* **accepts no liability for loss or damage to entries** and insures the Exhibition for Third Party Risk only. Artists may arrange their own insurance if they wish.
- (g) A commission of 20% will be charged on all pictures sold during the Exhibition. Pictures will be sold only at the price stated in the catalogue.
- (h) All members submitting pictures **must** volunteer to act as stewards **twice** during the Exhibition or provide a substitute (see Newsletter). Members not submitting pictures are also encouraged to steward.

Handing In

- ❖ Include a non-returnable fee of £2 for each picture for sale, and £3 for NFS pictures and 3D items
- ❖ The enclosed form should be completed and sent to Roger Smith with the fee by 11th July at the latest
- ❖ Entries to be brought to the Telfer Hall Gypsy Lane on Monday 21 July between 9:00am and 10:30am
- ❖ **No entries may be removed before Sunday 10th August between 10:00am to 12:00noon.**

Please note carefully the following picture requirements:

- (i) Pictures must be well-framed (no clips or frameless glass) and ready for hanging with rings or eyes screwed to the back and a **tight**, strong string or wire. They **must be sealed at the back with gummed or masking tape covering the pins or clips**. Pictures **must be firmly fixed** in the frames which must be of good appearance. Pictures on boxed canvas painted round the edges are acceptable. Any queries about framing should be referred to the President **before submission of the entry form**.
- (ii) 3-D items must have no sharp edges or projections, and be stable when displayed.
- (iii) One of the enclosed gummed labels must be filled in for each entry, stuck to the luggage label provided with a hole on the left (see diagram) and attached to the picture cord with a string long enough to hang over the front.
- (iv) The **same information** must be supplied on the back of the entry.
- (v) Pictures which do not comply with the above requirements or which have loose, damaged or over-elaborate frames will not be accepted.

The Exhibition

The **Private View Party** will be held on Wednesday 23rd July at 7:30pm. The Guests **of Honour will be who** will select the winners of the Norah Pearse Prizes and perform the official opening of the Exhibition. The party will be free of charge for members. Owing to the severe overcrowding in recent years we regret that only members and officially invited guests will be admitted.

Admission to the Exhibition will be by catalogue price 50p for non-members. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult and will be admitted free. No dogs are allowed.

The Exhibition will close at 4:30pm on Saturday 9th August and members may collect their paintings between 10:00am to 12:00noon on Sunday 10th August.
