Postcards | Thank you to members for all of the striking images you have sent for the postcards. If you are intending submitting something could I ask that you email me yours by 8th August as we need to give the printers sufficient time to produce the cards.

Publicity | We are hoping for a high number of visitors to the Exhibition which could be enhanced by the Tour of Britain Cycle Race finishing on Exmouth seafront. So we hope we can rely on you to publicise our event. The car stickers and poster will be on the website in August for your to print off and display or I can send you copies.
